Overview

This bill provides educational assistance (GI benefits) to translators who assisted United States troops in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Section

- 1 Eligibility.** Extends the educational assistance to veterans program to Iraqi and Afghani translators who assisted the United States military and subsequently received legal status in the U.S. and settled in Minnesota.
- 2 Apprenticeship and on-the-job training.** Extends eligibility for the veterans apprenticeship and on-the-job training program to translators eligible for GI benefits under section 1.
- 3 Rulemaking.** Directs the Commissioner of Administration to adopt rules to implement this policy.
- 4 Effective date.** Establishes July 1, 2018, as the effective date for the policy.
