Overview

Permits school districts and schools to maintain a supply of asthma inhalers, and enter into arrangements with manufacturers to obtain asthma inhalers.

Section

1 Districts and schools may maintain supply of asthma inhalers. Allows districts and schools to obtain, possess, and administer asthma inhalers. Allows school personnel to administer asthma inhalers to persons having asthma attacks, with or without a prescription. Excludes asthma inhalers from limits on who may possess, administer, or dispense legend drugs. Declares that administering asthma inhalers is not practicing medicine.

2 Arrangements with manufacturers. Allows contracts with makers of asthma inhalers and allows third parties to pay for the costs of the school's supply of asthma inhalers.
