Overview

Permits school districts and schools to maintain a supply of asthma inhalers, and enter into arrangements with manufacturers to obtain asthma inhalers.

Section

- 1 Districts and schools may maintain supply of asthma inhalers.** Allows districts and schools to obtain, possess, and administer asthma inhalers. Allows school personnel to administer asthma inhalers to persons having asthma attacks, with or without a prescription. Excludes asthma inhalers from limits on who may possess, administer, or dispense legend drugs. Declares that administering asthma inhalers is not practicing medicine.
- 2 Arrangements with manufacturers.** Allows contracts with makers of asthma inhalers and allows third parties to pay for the costs of the school's supply of asthma inhalers.
