- 1 **Advanced practice registered nurses primary care practice workforce retention study.** Directs the commissioner of health to award a grant to a nonprofit medical research foundation to study retention of APRNs in primary care practices and the high rate of APRN burnout. Requires the grantee to develop a survey tool, collect workforce data, create a process to share the data collected, make recommendations for possible solutions to address burnout, and report on the study to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health care workforce issues, by October 1, 2018.
- 2 **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$300,000 in fiscal year 2018 from the general fund to the commissioner of health for the APRN study.
