Overview

General education revenue is primarily provided through state aid, although a few of the general education components have an equalized levy attached as well. These levy shares are subtracted from the amount of general education aid the district would otherwise receive. For a few years, an equalized levy, called the student achievement levy, was in place and reduced general education aid by the amount of the levy (\$20 million per year in its first three years and \$10 million in its final year). This levy was repealed by the 2015 legislature effective for fiscal years 2019 and later.

This bill removes obsolete language relating to the student achievement levy from the calculation of general education aid.
