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Subject:	Late payments for property taxes
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Overview

Under current law, the penalties for late payments of property taxes due in the second-half of the year are higher than they are for late first-half payments. This bill equalizes the penalties for first- and second-half late payments of property taxes. The bill also restructures the existing statute for clarity.

Section

1 Due dates and penalties. Reduces the penalty rate for late payments of second-half property taxes due on homestead and nonhomestead properties to correspond to the penalties for late payments on first-half property taxes. Clarifies the formula for determining the penalty rates.

Adds new paragraphs clarifying and restating current statutory provisions regarding how due dates and/or penalties apply when: a property tax statement has been mailed out late, property taxes are under \$100, and a commercial seasonal recreational property earns 60% of its gross income during the summer months.

2 Agricultural property. Reduces the penalty rate for late payments of second-half property taxes due on agricultural homestead and agricultural nonhomestead properties to correspond to the penalties for late payments on first-half property taxes.

Deletes a provision applicable to tax payable in 2010 and 2011.
