This bill modifies some of the requirements for a restricted driver's license that can be issued for farm work, to:

- permit unaccompanied driving within 40 miles of the farmhouse, which is increased from 20 miles; and
- clarify that the license is available for work on any type of farm, regardless of how it is legally constituted.

The restricted farm work license functions as a hybrid between an instruction permit and a provisional license, allowing for unaccompanied driving to assist in farming activities.
