Overview

This bill, if passed, would define the term "telemedicine" and make clear that the same standards apply to both the in-person practice of medicine and the practice of telemedicine under the Minnesota Medical Practice Act.

Section

1 Practice of telemedicine. Proposes coding for § 147.033. Defines "telemedicine;" specifies that a physician-patient relationship may be established via telemedicine; specifies that the same standards of practice and conduct apply to physicians providing services via telemedicine as would apply to in-person services.
