Permits the trustees of a county law library with reserves sufficient to finance the library for five years to transfer up to half, but not more than \$200,000, to the county to build a new building for the law library and courts.

Law library funds come from fees assessed by the courts as part of litigation. In addition, under Minnesota Statutes, section 134A.15, a county board may provide for additional support and maintenance of the county law library out of county funds.
