Overview

Creates a rental assistance program for homeless and highly mobile students.

Section

- Modifies the housing trust fund and family homeless prevention and assistance program requirements to create a rental assistance program for highly mobile students. Targets unaccompanied homeless youth and families with children eligible for enrollment in prekindergarten through grade 12 academic programs who are homeless or have overcrowded, unaffordable, unstable, or inadequate housing. Provides such people assistance that may include rental subsidies, case management, and housing navigation, in order to boost school attendance.
- Appropriates \$4,000,000 per year to the Housing Finance Agency for the rental assistance to highly mobile students program created in sections 1 and 2 and another \$1,000,000 per year to the Housing Finance Agency for the school stability program.
