This bill authorizes municipalities to canvass the results of their primary elections on either the second or third day after the primary is conducted.

Under current law, the results of a municipal primary must be canvassed on the third day after it is conducted, if the primary was held in conjunction with the state primary election. A canvass on the second day is permitted only if the appropriate county auditor(s) agree to review the necessary voting data for accuracy and completeness in time for the canvass to be conducted. The bill would remove that condition.
