Overview

This bill modifies an exception to the moratorium on the development of Group Residential Housing (GRH) beds.

GRH is a state program that provides payments on behalf of eligible persons to pay for room and board and related housing services.

In order to be eligible for GRH payments, an individual must be determined eligible for residence in a GRH setting and must: (1) be aged, blind, or over 18 years of age and disabled, and meet specified income and asset standards; or (2) belong to certain categories of individuals potentially eligible for GA and meet specified income and asset standards.

1 Moratorium on development of group residential housing beds. Amends § 256I.04, subd. 3. Modifies an exception to the moratorium on the development of GRH beds by increasing the number of supportive housing units that are allowed in Anoka, Dakota, Hennepin, or Ramsey County for homeless adults with a mental illness, a history of substance abuse, or HIV/AIDS.
