Overview

This bill modifies the long-term care services and supports report and makes appropriations for the report each year, rather than biennially.

Section

- Balancing long-term care services and supports; report required. Amends § 144A.351. States that any amounts appropriated for the report are available in either year of the biennium. Removes obsolete language.
- **2 Central office.** Amends Laws 2013, ch. 108, art. 15, § 2, subd. 2. Removes a rider appropriating money for the long-term services and supports report.
- **Gap analysis; appropriation.** Appropriates \$217,500 in each year of the 2018-2019 biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for analysis of gaps in long-term care services.
