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Section

1 Housing trust funds for local housing development.

- **Subd. 1. Definitions.** Defines commissioner, fund, local government (county or city), local housing trust fund, and regional housing trust fund (established by joint powers).
- **Subd. 2. Creation and administration.** Permits a local government to establish a local housing trust fund by ordinance or participate in a joint powers agreement to establish a regional housing trust fund. Permits a regional housing trust fund to be administered through a nonprofit organization that must encourage private donations.
 - **Subd. 3. Authorized expenditures.** Specifies use of funds.
 - **Subd. 4. Funding.** Permits local government spending for the trust fund.
- **Subd. 5. Matching contributions.** For the next biennium only, if a trust fund gets money from a housing and redevelopment authority, the Housing Finance Agency must give to the trust a matching amount up to \$100,000 and 50 percent of the amount over that, up to \$500,000. Allows eight years to spend the money, which must be spent on activities serving individuals and households with incomes at or below 115 percent of the state median income.
 - **Subd. 6. Reports.** Requires reports.
- **Subd. 7. Effect on existing local or regional housing trust funds.** Grandfathers in existing local housing trust funds but requires existing trust funds to conform with any alteration or amendment to its governing documents.

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Appropriation. Appropriates \$1 million in each year of the biennium to the Housing Finance Agency to make matching contributions and provides for proportionate distribution if necessary.
