This bill would allow new early childhood programs to become eligible to accept early learning scholarships. Currently, programs must have a three- or four-star rating in the quality rating and improvement system to accept the scholarships. This bill would allow new programs affiliated with programs that already have a three- or four-star rating to accept the scholarships, as long as the on-site director of the new program has managerial experience operating a three- or four-star rated program.
