Overview

The Collaborative Urban Educator (CUE) grants fund four teacher training programs intended to expand the diversity of Minnesota's teacher workforce. The grant recipients are named in law and include: the Southeast Asian teacher (SEAT) program at Concordia University; the Collaborative Urban Educator (CUE) program at St. Thomas; The Center of Excellence in Urban Teaching program at Hamline University; and the East African Student to Teacher (EAST) program at Augsburg College.

This bill appropriates \$1 million per year to fund each of the four CUE recipients at \$250,000 per year. The base budget for this program is \$195,000 per year per program.
