## Overview

This bill expands the ability of a trade association for motor fuel retailers to access driver records when they act on behalf of a member retailer who has had motor fuel taken without payment. The bill also clarifies data practices law regarding the use of vehicle registration data.

### Section

- 1 Motor vehicle registration.** Amends the “public safety data coded elsewhere” section of the Data Practices Act to clarify that the use of vehicle registration data is governed by section 168.345.
- 2 Records and fees.** Expands the fee exemption for inquiries on driver and vehicle records. Allows trade associations for motor fuel retailers to inquire into vehicle records without a fee, if the association is acting on behalf of a retailer who had fuel taken without payment.
- 3 Lessees; information.** Allows the Department of Public Safety to provide information about vehicle lessees to trade associations for motor fuel retainers, if the association is acting on behalf of a retailer who had fuel taken without payment.
