This bill establishes a Legislative Commission on Cyber Security. The commission would consist of three senators and three representatives.

Various details related to the administrative organization of the commission are specified in the bill. The commission's duty is to provide oversight of state cyber security measures, including review of policies and practices of state agencies, and recommending changes in policy and law to protect against threats.

The commission's first meeting is required no later than June 15, 2017.
