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## Overview

This bill modifies the postsecondary enrollment options (PSEO) program. High school students in PSEO take college classes for college credit either at the college or university, or online.

### Section

- 1**        **Definitions.** Expands definition of “eligible institutions” to include postsecondary institutions in Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. This definition is used to determine the institutions that may provide PSEO courses and concurrent enrollment courses for postsecondary credit.
- 2**        **Enrollment priority.** Eliminates limits on postsecondary institutions’ ability to advertise or recruit high school students.
- 3**        **Concurrent Enrollment Advisory Board.** Adds current and former concurrent enrollment students to list of groups that should be represented on the Concurrent Enrollment Advisory Board.
- 4**        **Access to computers.** Requires a school to provide a student enrolled in PSEO and concurrent enrollment courses the same access to computers and software that it provides to other students in the school.
- 5**        **Credits; grade point average weighting dispute.** Allows a student to appeal a school board’s decision regarding a weighted grade point average for a particular course to the commissioner of education.

- 6**      **Eligible programs.** Allows students that qualify for graduation incentives program to enroll in charter schools.
