Creates a pilot program providing tax credits for employers participating in youth skills training programs that would be created under H.F. 631. Up to ten employers participating in Department of Labor and Industry approved programs could receive credits, subject to geographical restrictions. Eligible employers could claim a refundable credit of \$2,000 per student learner participating in the program and working for the employer.
