This bill establishes several performance outcome requirements for the Office of MN.IT Services. These outcomes include:

- (1) completion of the state agency IT consolidation originally required in 2011;
- (2) increased use of public cloud solutions to host servers and store data;
- (3) reduction in the number of data centers;
- (4) reduction in the total cost of MN.IT personnel by at least \$3,000,000; and
- (5) a report to the legislature on consolidation of business application software across agencies.

In addition, the bill requires quarterly reports on state agency technology projects which require the participation of MN.IT. The report must include status updates on the projects, including estimated costs of the information technology components and an expected date of completion.
