Overview

This bill restricts the ability of a Minnesota State or University of Minnesota campus to increase mandatory student life or student activity fees.

Section

- 1 Student life or activity fees. Requires that any increase in student life or student activity fees must first be approved by a vote of the student body. Student life and student activity fees do not include fees for educational or health services, or optional fees.
- 2 **Base appropriation; student fee penalty.** Imposes a penalty on the University of Minnesota if it violates the requirements imposed by section 1. A violation results in the commissioner of Minnesota Management and Budget deducting an amount equal to the net revenue generated by the fee increase from the university's base appropriation in the first year of the next biennium.
