### Overview

H.F. 2254 moves the application date for the senior deferral program from July 1 to November 1, and specifies that incomplete applications must be designated as pending until either approved or denied. The bill also clarifies that applications may be initial applications or corrective applications.

#### Section

- 1** **Application.** Moves the application date for the senior deferral program from July 1 to November 1, and clarifies that applications received after that date, along with those not approved prior to December 1, will be considered for approval the following year. Also removes references to “initial” applications and clarifies that applications may be initial or corrective.
- 2** **Approval; recording.** Provides that the commissioner must neither approve nor deny an incomplete application for a period of 60 days from initial receipt, or until all information required by the commissioner has been received. Provides that the commissioner must designate all applications as pending until they are approved or denied.
- 3** **Determination by commissioner.** Removes a reference to “initial” applications and replaces it with a reference to an “approved” application.
- 4** **Revisor’s instruction.** Instructs the revisor to change most references to “initial application” to “application” and to change one of the references to “approved” application.
