Creates the central Minnesota opportunity grant program of competitive grants to nonprofit organizations to provide economic development, education, and housing services to communities of color in the St. Cloud area. Establishes the Central Minnesota Community Foundation as the administrator of the competitive grant program and outlines application requirements, evaluation criteria, and allowed expenses. Requires reports to the legislature and appropriates \$1,000,000 a year to the program through fiscal year 2021.
