Overview

This bill amends the campus sexual assault statute to require the University of Minnesota to collect and report statistical data on incidents of sexual harassment in the same manner that it currently must for incidents of sexual assault. It also requests the legislative auditor to review the University's sexual harassment policies and procedures.

Section

- 1. Data collection and reporting. Requires the University of Minnesota to collect statistical data on sexual harassment. The types of data that must be collected are coextensive with the current requirements for sexual assault data. As with other data currently collected under this subdivision, the sexual harassment data must be reported to the Office of Higher Education and published on the University's website.
- **2. Legislative auditor review**. Requests the legislative auditor, by March 1, 2018, to complete a review of sexual harassment policies and procedures at the University of Minnesota.
