This bill requires that at least five percent of a state department or agency's IT budget for each fiscal year be dedicated to maintenance and enhancement of cyber security.

The bill also requires the governor's biennial budget recommendations to include an itemization of recommended expenditures specifically for cyber security. The total recommended for cyber security each fiscal year must be at least five percent of the total operating budget for IT systems and services.

The commissioner of management and budget, in consultation with the state chief information officer, is required to adopt budget guidelines for these recommendations.
