Overview

This bill appropriates \$10 million from the general fund for the Minnesota Licensing and Registration System (MNLARS) and requires a corresponding \$10 million reduction in state appropriations for the 2018-19 biennium.

MNLARS Supplemental appropriation.

Subd. 1. Supplemental appropriation. Appropriates \$10 million from the general fund in fiscal year 2018 for ongoing work on the Minnesota Licensing and Registration System (MNLARS), which matches a supplemental budget recommendation from the governor.

Subd. 2. Executive agency appropriations; targeted reductions. Directs MMB to reduce appropriations to the executive branch and constitutional offices (such as the State Auditor) by \$10 million for the 2018-19 biennium, following approval of the governor and consultation with the Legislative Advisory Commission. The reductions must occur prior to release of the appropriated funds in subdivision 1. Sets prioritization and limits on activities for which funding can be reduced.
