This bill modifies requirements for signs under MnDOT's "specific service sign" program, which provides guide signs on the nonfreeway trunk highway system in Greater Minnesota. It broadens the business hours of operation conditions so that a farm winery serving food through a staffed food operation has to be open at least four hours a day, two days a week.

Under current law, businesses serviced by a sign through the program must be open at least eight hours a day and six days a week.
