Overview

This bill requires a school district to establish a threat assessment team for every school in the district, and requires the team to assess and intervene when individuals may pose a threat to safety.

Section

- **1 Private data; when disclosure is permitted.** Allows private data to be disclosed to a member of a school threat assessment team.
- 2 School threat assessment team and oversight committee.

Subd. 1. School threat assessment team; membership. Requires a school district to establish a threat assessment team for every school. The team must include members with expertise in specific areas.

Subd. 2. Threat assessment team; duties. Requires the threat assessment team to assess and intervene with individuals whose behavior may pose a threat to the safety of school staff or students.

Subd. 3. Report to superintendent; records. Requires the threat assessment team to report to the superintendent team's a determination that a student poses a threat to self or others. The superintendent must immediately notify the student's parent or guardian. Allows the team to obtain criminal history record information and health records. Requires the team to annually report summary data on its activities to the superintendent.

<u>Section</u>

Subd. 4. Oversight committee; membership. Allows the school district to establish a committee with oversight of the threat assessment teams within the district.

3 Appropriation. Appropriates funds to the commissioner of education for threat assessment teams and oversight committees.
