## Overview

This bill contains provisions being recommended by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) that modify the state's game and fish laws.

## **Section**

- **1 Summary of fish and game laws.** Amends § 97A.051, subd. 2. Removes a requirement that the DNR supply license vendors with one copy of the fishing, hunting, and trapping regulations for each person getting a license.
- 2 Discretionary separate selection; eligibility. Amends § 97A.433, subd. 5. Allows landowners/tenants of land eligible for a separate selection process for elk hunting licenses to sell the license to any state resident eligible to hunt elk. The license may not be sold for more than the original cost of the license.
- 3 Mandatory separate selection. Amends § 97A.433, subd. 5. Requires the DNR to put the name of a person who is unsuccessful in a separate elk license drawing for those who have applied at least ten times without receiving one to be put in the drawing for the remaining licenses.
