This bill directs the commissioner of human services to allow a BI and CADI waivers customized living services provider located in Minneapolis to transfer capacity to up to three new housing with services settings located in Hennepin County. The bill requires the commissioner to determine the new housing with services establishments meet the BI and CADI waiver customized living size limitation exception for clients receiving those services at the new establishments.

The BI waiver provides services for individuals with brain injury who need the level of care provided in a nursing home or neurobehavioral hospital.

The CADI waiver provides services for individuals with disabilities who need the level of care provided in a nursing home.
