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Overview

This bill adds new drugs to the controlled substance schedules in chapter 152.

Section

1 **Schedule I.** Adds the following drugs to Schedule I of the controlled substance schedules:

- (1) mitragynine;
- (2) 7-hydroxymitragynine; and
- (3) 4-(4-bromophenyl)-4-dimethylamino-1-phenethylcyclohexanol (bromadol).

Schedule I drugs have a high potential for abuse, no currently accepted medical use in the United States, and a lack of accepted safety for use under medical supervision.

2 **Schedule IV.** Adds the following drugs to Schedule IV of the controlled substance schedules:

- (1) pentazocine; and
- (2) butorphanol (including its optical isomers).

Schedule IV drugs have a low potential for abuse relative to the substances in Schedule III, currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States, and that abuse may lead to limited physical dependence or psychological dependence relative to the substances in Schedule III.
