Appropriates money for grants to local communities to increase the supply of child care providers. Requires that 60 percent or more of grants go to communities in outstate Minnesota, that recipients obtain 50 percent nonstate matching funds (in cash or in-kind), and that communities with documented shortages of providers have priority. Requires reports to the legislature on grant outcomes.
