This bill directs the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) to perform a study on ensuring safety and quality in the transportation of unaccompanied minors receiving mental health services. It requires coordination with other state agencies and specifies questions and topics to address, including descriptive information on minors requiring transportation services, assessment of fiscal implications, and examination of safety and liability issues. The report is due by January 15, 2019.

The bill also makes an appropriation, in an amount to be determined, from the general fund for the study.
