Overview

This bill requires the commissioner of human services to update a 2007 legislative report on runaway and homeless youth.

Section

- 1 2018 Report to the Legislature on Runaway and Homeless Youth.
 - **Subd. 1. Report development.** Requires the commissioner of human services to update the information in the 2007 legislative report on runaway and homeless youth. Requires the commissioner to use existing data, studies, and analysis provided by state, county, and other listed entities.
 - **Subd. 2. Key elements; due date.** Paragraph (a) requires the report to include three key elements where significant learning has occurred in the state since the 2007 report.

Paragraph (b) lists information the report must include.

Paragraph (c) requires the commissioner of human services to: (1) consult with and incorporate the expertise of community-based providers of homeless youth services and other expert stakeholders to complete the report; and (2) submit the report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over youth homelessness by December 15, 2018.
