- Bill Summary -

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Overview

This bill authorizes the Department of Human Services and the Metropolitan Council to share certain data about individuals to whom the agencies provide special transportation services. Effective the day after enactment.

Section

- 1 General (Data Practices Act). Creates an exception to the provision making data on individuals collected, maintained, used, or disseminated by the welfare system private data on individuals. Allows disclosure of private data between the Department of Human Services and the Metropolitan Council in order to coordinate special transportation services between the agencies and to provide for reimbursements.
- 2 Transportation service data (Data Practices Act). Allows disclosure of private data between the Department of Human Services and the Metropolitan Council in order to coordinate special transportation services between the agencies and to provide for reimbursements.
- **3 Duties of the council (Metropolitan Council statute).** Adds to the Metro Mobility service area any area added to the transit taxing district that received capital improvements financed in part by the Minnesota Urban Partnership Agreement (UPA).
- 4 **Data practices (Metropolitan Council statute).** Adds a data practices subdivision specifying what data may be shared between the Department of Human Services and the Metropolitan Council for purposes of administering special transportation services. Requires the data subject to give consent prior to data sharing.
