## Overview

This bill provides that a single well notification fee of \$275 (instead of \$275 per boring) applies to all environmental wells marked on a borings map and submitted to the commissioner of health and commissioner of natural resources.

## **Section**

- Well notification fee. Amends § 103I.208, subd. 1. Provides that a single well notification fee of \$275, paid by the property owner to the commissioner of health, must be paid for construction of all environmental wells that are located on a map of borings that must be submitted to the commissioner of health and commissioner of natural resources showing the locations of exploratory borings.
- Notification and map of borings. Amends § 103I.601, subd. 4. Makes a change to conform with section 1, by providing that one \$275 fee must be submitted for all borings marked on the map, not \$275 per exploratory boring.
