Overview

This is 2018 omnibus liquor bill.

Section

- 1 Brew on premises store.** Authorizes a brew on premises store to provide tastings of alcoholic beverages produced at the store without obtaining a license.
- 2 Winemaking on premises store.** Authorizes a winemaking on premises store to provide tastings of alcoholic beverages produced at the store without obtaining a license.
- 3 Intoxicating liquor; off-sale.** Allows extended off-sale hours to 8:00 p.m. if Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve falls on a Sunday. Modifies Sunday off-sale hours from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- 4 Special license: Hubbard County off-sale license.** Authorizes Hubbard County to issue an off-sale license to an exclusive liquor store in Akeley Township.
- 5 Special license; City of North Mankato.** Authorizes a special on-sale license for the Caswell Regional Sporting Complex.
- 6 Special license; City of Minneapolis.** Authorizes a special on-sale license for a restaurant at 5400 Penn Ave. S.
- 7 Special license; City of Minneapolis.** Authorizes a special on-sale license for a restaurant at 4959 Penn Ave. S.
- 8 Special license; City of Edina.** Authorizes a special license to a retailer at 6801 France Ave. S.

9 **Special license; City of Minneapolis.** Authorizes a special license for a business at 3753 Nicollet Ave. S.
