Under current law, it is a felony to throw or otherwise transfer urine, blood, or semen onto an employee or other individual who supervises and works directly with patients at a secure treatment facility while the person is engaged in that employment.

This bill expands the acts that constitute a felony to include throwing or otherwise transferring any bodily fluid at or onto the person.
