Overview

This bill allows cardiovascular technologists who satisfy certain educational requirements to operate fluoroscopy equipment without passing an examination required for limited x-ray operators.

Section

Limited x-ray machine operator practice. Amends § 144.121, subd. 5a. Allows cardiovascular technologists who are graduates of an accredited education program related to cardiovascular technology to operate fluoroscopy equipment to diagnose or treat a disease or condition of the cardiovascular system, without passing an examination required for limited x-ray operators. A cardiovascular technologist operating under this clause must be under the direct supervision and physical presence of a licensed practitioner.
