This bill makes changes related to the accounts used by Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) in the Department of Public Safety, to:

- create a new DVS fund in the state treasury;
- move into the DVS fund the operating accounts for driver services and vehicle services, as
 well as the DVS technology account that holds funding the Minnesota Licensing and
 Registration System (MNLARS), which shifts these accounts out of the special revenue fund;
 and
- make technical changes.

The bill also contains technical changes to remove language on technology surcharges that expired at the end of fiscal year 2016. (The surcharges were imposed on driver licensing and motor vehicle titling and registration, and had provided revenue to the DVS technology account for MNLARS development and implementation.)
