## Overview

This bill regulates security screening systems in general and, specifically, as they are used in correctional facilities.

## **Section**

- Fees for ionizing radiation-producing equipment. Requires facilities that use radiation producing security screening systems to pay the commissioner of health \$100 for each system in use. This fee is in addition to the \$100 base registration fee.
- **Exemption from examination requirements; operators of security screening systems.**Exempts security screening systems used in correctional facilities as well as the operators of these systems from certain statutory and regulatory requirements enforced by the Department of Health.
- **Rulemaking.** Authorizes the commissioner of health to undertake rule-making to implement section 2.
- **Appropriation.** Appropriates an unspecified amount from the state government special revenue fund to the commissioner of health in 2019.
