Summary

This bill establishes a duty for peace officers to intercede when another officer is using excessive force and report incidents of excessive force to supervisors. Failure of a peace officer to intercede or report excessive force subjects the officer to POST Board discipline. The bill requires the POST Board to develop a model policy on the duty to intercede and for each law enforcement agency to adopt a conforming policy.
