Overview

This bill repeals the statute that prohibits school districts from starting school before Labor Day, starting in the 2020-2021 school year. The current statute contains some exceptions to the Labor Day prohibition, and certain exceptions have been granted in session law. In 2015, the legislature allowed districts to start the 2015-2016 school year on September 1 because Labor Day fell later in the calendar than usual. The Chaska school district was granted an exception to the Labor Day prohibition when the 2016 Ryder Cup was held in the area.
