Overview

This bill establishes a Rotary International special license plate. Among the requirements to obtain the plate, a vehicle owner must donate \$25 on initial application and \$5 annually for Rotary International.

1	<p>[§ 168.1283] Rotary International plates. Creates a new Rotary International special license plate. Plate application and issuance begins January 1, 2020.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Issuance of plates. Sets requirements to obtain the special plate, including ownership of an eligible passenger-type vehicle or motorcycle, payment of a \$10 fee as well as other applicable fees and taxes, and a donation of \$25 for the first application and \$5 annually after that.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Design. Directs the Department of Public Safety to design the plate with a Rotary International symbol and the inscription "Service Above Self."</p> <p>Subd. 3. Plates transfer. Sets a \$5 fee and requirements in order to transfer the plate to another qualifying vehicle.</p> <p>Subd. 4. Exemption. Exempts the plates from application requirements governing new special license plate proposals, including a survey, marketing strategy, and application fee.</p> <p>Subd. 5. Fees. Identifies deposit of fee revenue.</p> <p>Subd. 6. Contributions; account; appropriation. Creates a Rotary Foundation account that holds the annual donation and makes a statutory appropriation of the donated funds. The appropriation is first for Department of Public Safety administrative costs, with the remaining funds distributed to Rotary Foundation to further the organization's mission.</p>
