Overview

Subject to restrictions, current law allows a municipality to issue a temporary on-sale license to clubs, nonprofit organizations, political committees, and state universities. However, current law prohibits a municipality from issuing more than one temporary license to a nonprofit organization or political committee, or for any one location, within any 30-day period.

The 30-day restriction does not apply to municipalities having a population of 5,000 or less. H.F. 1031 would increase the threshold for this exception to 10,000.
