Overview

H.F. 1033 authorizes the city of St. Paul to issue an off-sale license to a hotel located in the city that formerly held an off-sale license. Current law only allows a city of the first class to issue off-sale licenses to exclusive liquor stores, except for off-sale licenses issued to a general food store holding an off-sale license on August 1, 1989, and a drugstore which held a license on or prior to May 1, 1994.
