Overview

Under current law, conservation officers only have the authority to enforce provisions of the driving while intoxicated chapter against individuals who are hunting while under the influence, or operating off-road recreational vehicles or motorboats.

This bill removes limitations on conservation officers and gives them the same authority as other peace officers under the DWI chapter.
