House File 1191 requires the commissioner of commerce to develop and the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission to approve a financial incentive to encourage public utilities to continue to invest in cost-effective energy conservation in residences after energy conservation from all customer classes reaches 1.75 percent of electric sales and 1.2 percent of natural gas sales. The new incentive is available to utilities only if the amount of conservation from residences that counts toward the latter thresholds is not less than the average amount over the most recent three years.
