

Subject Customized Living Services Provider Transfer of Capacity

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Overview

This bill: (1) allows a housing with services establishment located in Minneapolis that provides customized living and 24-hour customized living services for clients enrolled in the MA brain injury (BI) or community access for disability inclusion (CADI) waiver and had a capacity to serve 66 clients as of July 1, 2017, to transfer service capacity of up to 66 clients to no more than three new housing with services establishments located in Hennepin County; and (2) requires the commissioner of human services to determine whether the new housing with services establishments meet the BI and CADI waiver customized living and 24-hour customized living size limitation exception for clients receiving those services at the new housing with services establishments.

The BI and CADI waivers are two of Minnesota's four MA home and community-based services disability waivers. These waivers cover two types of services: (1) services necessary to avoid institutionalization that are not offered in Minnesota's MA state plan, and (2) services that are extensions of Minnesota's MA state plan services.

The BI waiver provides services for individuals with brain injury who need the level of care provided in a nursing home or neurobehavioral hospital.

The CADI waiver provides services for individuals with disabilities who need the level of care provided in a nursing home.
